Right now known issues exists as below list.

Problems when using with impaired vision

- Contrasts not always within approved values when the app is running in so-called dark mode in IOS.
- It is not possible to affect the size of text in iOS in some cases.
- Tab focus and tab order are not always correct, which can be difficult for some users, for example if screen readers are used.
- It happens that it is not possible to increase the distance between characters, words and lines.

Problems that may arise for other users with disabilities, e.g. cognitive or hearing impairment

- Tab focus and tab order are not always correct, which can be difficult for some users, for example if voice control is used.
- Some clickable surfaces are not of sufficient size.
- It happens that text is in not in local language and is not marked with a language code even with English as the selected language.
- It happens that some services do not respect the user's settings, which means that it is not possible to use, for example, dark mode.
